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IMPLOSION RESISTANT CANISTER (2000CC / 3000CC)

Instructions for Use



INTENDED USE

For collection and disposal of aspirated fluid.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Check canister for cracks or other damage. If any defects are present, replace canister.
- 2. Place lid on top of canister and press down around entire perimeter to seal lid.
- 3. Apply pour port cap firmly over pour port (B). Apply tandem port cap tightly over tandem port (D) if it will not be used.
- 4. Attach aspiration tubing to patient port (C). Attach vacuum tubing from aspirator to vacuum port (A). Tubing must fit snugly.
- 5. Check that all caps and connections are properly sealed. Test the canister for vacuum leaks by turning on vacuum source and blocking the aspiration tubing.

Note: do not exceed a vacuum level of 25"Hg (85kPa)

DISPOSAL

- 1. Turn vacuum dial to minimum on aspirator.
- 2. Turn off vacuum source, wait for 10 seconds, and disconnect all tubing.
- 3. Seal all ports with available port caps.
- 4. Remove canister from canister mount and transport to disposal area.
- 5. **DO NOT** lift canister by lid. The weight of the contents may cause the lid to separate from the canister.
- 6. Dispose of according to your disposal policy.

CAUTION

NON-STERILE. Single Use Only. Do not attempt to clean, sterilize, or reuse canister. Fragile, handle with care.

- **DO NOT** exceed a vacuum level of 25"Hg
- Reuse may result in canister cracking, implosion and/or contamination.
- Store in a dark place. Long term exposure to light may compromise product performance and result in breakage during use.
- **DO NOT** use canister in case of any visible cracks or if dropped. If a canister with a crack is used and leaks during the procedure, replace the leaking canister with a new canister.
- Canister is not intended to be used as a measuring device. Graduation markings are for reference only, not specific measurement.
- If there is a loss of vacuum: Check that the aspirator is on, lid is firmly sealed, and all tubing connections are tight and not kinked. If vacuum loss continues, replace canister.
- Avoid canister and canister mount contact against sharp edges.
- DO NOT make any modifications to canister or lid.
